According to the Fair and Accurate Credit Transactions Act (FACT Act), consumers are entitled to receive one credit report, free of charge, from each of the three consumer credit bureaus (Equifax, TransUnion, and Experian). You may request a report once every 12 months from each reporting agency via:
